

Planning and Response

Added Character Counter to Incident Description Fields

The new **Characters remaining** counter has been added to the **Incident Description** field for incident response guides. As you enter or change the description, the counter automatically lets you know how many characters you have left before you reach the field's limit of 2,000 characters.

This feature has also been added to the Incident Description/ Notification Message field in the create incident workflow.


Enhanced Plan Copy Options

When you copy a plan to create a new one, you can now choose to copy the original plan's candidates and contacts to your new plan. The copied contacts appear in the depth charts for the same positions as in the original plan. Copying can save time since you may have fewer position assignments to set up or change for your new plan.


After copying the plan, go to **Planning: Plan Summary** and select the new plan from the **Plan** field toward the top of the page. When you click the **ICS Chart** option in the left pane, the right pane now shows the

new Copy candidates/
contacts from plan
field. Select the plan you
want to copy from and
then click Copy.

A confirmation message opens, indicating the numbers of positions and groups copied to your new plan.



To assist you in this process, the *Create a Plan* quick reference guide is available for download from the *Create New Plan* window—simply click the **Download Instructions** link. This guide walks you through all



steps in the plan creation workflow, including the new **Copy candidates/ contacts from plan** feature.








Document Location

The layout of each area's main page has changed, as shown in these images of the Library.

To view the structure and locate a document, simply expand library folders.

The new interface shows the full library structure, just as in the current interface.






In addition, in the new interface you can view a document directly from the library structure by clicking the document's name.

In each interface you can also search for a particular document.





Library Action Options


The eICS library offers a number of options for managing files and folders, including editing and renaming.

In the current interface, you must open the file's details to have access to the action buttons.



In the new interface, you can access several actions directly from the list of documents. For instance, you can rename a folder or edit a file.


The options to check a file out or in are available from the file details, which you can access by clicking the **Edit** option in the action menu.



List of Contacts


The Contacts area has undergone a number of changes.

In the current version, the contact list shows each contact's name and organization. Additional details are available when you open a contact's record.

The new layout offers more information up front. In addition to the contact's name and organization, the list includes each contact's primary phone number and shows the status of the contact and their user account.




Contact Details

The current interface shows contact details in a series of drawers.




Contact details have been re-organized in the new interface. Key details, including account and login information, appear on the main page.

Settings
