

EMResource[®] 4.1 Release Notes

These notes describe highlights of the EMResource 4.1 release scheduled for Wednesday, April 13, 2022. More information is available through the help in your solution or by contacting the Juvare Support at 877-771-0911 or <u>support@juvare.com</u>.

Display the Number of Selected Resource Rights

When editing the Resource Rights section of a user's profile, the number of resources to which you have assigned View, Associated, Update, and Report rights is now displayed.

Resource Type Filter Update

When filtering by resource type in the Resource Rights section of your profile, resource rights are now presented in a list instead of having to enter the type manually.

Remove the Update Count From Events on the Event Bar

On the event bar, the word 'Update' and the number of the update no longer precede event names. For example, what used to appear as *Update 8: COVID Hospital Capacity* now simply reads *COVID Hospital Capacity*. However, the update information is retained and presented elsewhere, such as on the Event List and reports.

List Notifications in Reverse Chronological Order

Previously listed by notification type, notifications in the notification center now appear in reverse chronological order with the most recent notification at the top.

Resolutions

- Changes that result from turning the High Contrast View on or off are now applied immediately after saving your User Profile.
- An issue related to Incoming Patient Notifications being sent to additional people has been resolved.
- In the top banner, the option to expand or contract the events bar was relabeled from *Active Events (#)* to *Events*.
- The physical address for events, when included, is now available in the event details (accessed by clicking an event in the event bar).
- On event details, the export button was unavailable for some people. Access to this button has since been restored and is again available according to permissions.
- On event details, the Download button now says Download Attachment.



- For ongoing events that do not have an end date, the assumed end date of 12/31/2999 has been removed from the event bar.
- Now, when an event has ended, the notification for that event is immediately removed from the event bar.
- Links in event notification emails now open the event in EMResource as expected.
- Updates to resource statuses now appear immediately after an update is saved.
- An issue that prevented locked user accounts from being unlocked with a password change after too many failed login attempts has been resolved.
