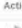





Standard and Optional Attribute Types

In Categories, after choosing an Item Type, Asset, Item, or Kit, the attribute types are now visible for Standard and Optional Attributes.

Resource Requests

- With an updated user interface, the workflow steps are clearly defined to help you manage the request.
- Additional information, including the Expiration Date, Serial #, and Lot # help you make the best decisions about which supplies to select for resource request fulfillment.

EMSupply API

The EMSupply API has been extended to allow for inventory deduction from external applications. For example, the quantity of COVID vaccines can be automatically updated in EMSupply as they are being administered through EMTrack.

Dose Attribute

Dose has been added to the attribute list, allowing you to see the amount or quantity of a medication that should be administered.

Vaccine Inventory

Allowing you to better manage vaccine supplies, inventory can now be marked as a “vaccine” and the Administered Code (CVX) and the Substance Manufacturer Code (MVX) can be entered.
