

## EMTrack™ 4.4.0 Release Notes

### Integration with Juvare Exchange

Introduced an integration with Juvare Exchange (JX) that allows you to send information such as incident data, facility data, and patient tracking summary data to JX. You can view the information shared with JX on a map. Incorporating patient tracking data into JX further enhances its common operating picture.

### Incident Summary Report

Added the ability to export the Incident Summary Report into Microsoft Excel, which offers an alternate way to organize and manage large amounts of data.

### Forms

Introduced a new Client Type component to forms that allows you to distinguish between person and patient. With this component, you are now able to identify the client as either a patient or a person. The “hidden” attribute allows setting the value at the form level. The component is available as a search term in filters and can be added to dashboard gadgets.

### Help

Launched a new repository for the Help documentation, which contains additional resources, including a video and quick reference guides on using EMTrack for vaccination tracking.

### Incident Locations

Added the ability to expand incident location information. When creating or updating an incident, you can now add well-known text (WKT) in place of latitude/longitude coordinates and can establish a line, polygon, or other symbol to represent the patient tracking scene, promoting greater accuracy in geographic monitoring and reporting.

### Improvements

Introduced several system improvements and security updates.
