Visualize Data in Juvare Exchange

Deidentified information about patients, including associated incidents and facilities, is now being sent to Juvare Exchange. For clients that use Juvare Exchange, this information offers a more complete common operating picture that helps you visualize mass casualty incidents or events where patient movement is involved.

Immunization History Search

The Immunization History Search was extended to include vaccinations administered between December 1, 2020, and the current date. This extension allows clinicians administering booster vaccines to view all COVID-19 vaccination data, including initial immunization records.

Deactivate Users in Bulk

Now, both password and PIN-enabled users can be selected and deactivated in bulk. As a result, administrators no longer need to deactivate individual user records after an event.

Resolutions

- The dates for Vaccine Information Statements (VIS) added to secondary medications on a patient record are now retained.
- Now, more than eight roles can be included on a search filter.
- On the search filter, criteria related to age range was updated so that only patients born within the specified year range display in the results.

Android 3.2.10 Mobile Release

The EMTrack mobile app for Android has been updated to prevent a possible security vulnerability. With this update, the minimum compatible version requirement for your device is Android 7 or higher.
