Only Juvare can assign a standard status type to a status type. However, if you are authorized to manage standard status types for a region, you can create a status type out of a standard status type. That new status type is then available for use in the region.

To manage standard status types

1. In the main menu, click **Setup** and, in the list, select **Regions**. The *Region List* opens.
2. Locate the region and, on that row, click **Std Status Types**. The *(region name) Region Standard Status Types* page opens.
3. Take any of these actions.
 - a. To make a standard status type available to the region, in the **Available?** column, select the checkbox.
 - b. To create a status type based on the standard status type, in the **Add as Status Type?** column, select the checkbox.
4. Click **Save**.
