## To set a sub-resource as primary

1. In the main menu, click **Setup** and then click **Resources**. The *Resource List* opens.
2. Locate the resource and, on that row, click **Sub-Resources**. The *Sub-Resource List for (resource)* page opens.
3. Locate the sub-resource and, in the **Primary** column, click **Set as Primary**.

**Tip:** You can also set a sub-resource as primary from its Update Sub-Resource for (resource) page.
