To review and print an HVA

1. Point to **Planning** and in the list, click **HVA**. The *Hazard Vulnerability Analysis* page opens.
2. If it is not already selected, in the **HVA for** list, click the name of the facility, health system, facility group, or coalition you want to view.
3. For health systems, facility groups, and coalitions, in the **Year** list, click the appropriate year. The page opens with assessment statuses and top risks.
4. To generate the HVA report, click **Print**. The report opens in a new browser tab, and you can choose to download or print it.
