

Create or Edit a Custom View

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A custom view can be created to display information about specific resources. This view can be accessed through the View menu, or it can be made to open as your default view. You can edit your customized view at any time.

To create or edit a custom view

1. In the main menu, click **Preferences** and, in the list, select **Customized View**. The *Edit Custom View* page opens.
2. Take one or more of these actions.

If you want to...	Then...
Add more resources to the custom view,	<div>a. Click Add More Resources. The <i>Find Resources</i> page opens.</div> <div>b. Enter search criteria in one or more fields and click Search. The search results open.</div> <div>c. On the left, select the checkbox for the resources you want to include in the view.</div> <div>d. Click Add to Custom View. The <i>Edit Custom View</i> page re-opens.</div>
To create a new section on the view,	On the lower left, enter the section name and click Create Section .
To move a resource to a new section,	<div>a. In the left pane, select the section where the resource currently resides.</div> <div>b. In the right pane, drag the resource to the left pane and drop it on the appropriate section.</div>
To change the order of sections,	<div>Do one or both of the following:</div> <div>a. Drag the section headers up or down in the left pane.</div> <div>b. Click Sort All.</div>

To change the order of resources within a section,	<p>Do one or both of the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Drag and drop the resource to its new location in the list. b. Click Sort in the section header.
To edit a section name,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. On the left, click the section name. The section is highlighted. b. On that row, click Edit. The name appears in a new field entitled, New name. c. Edit the section name and click Submit.
To delete a section,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. On the left, click the section name. The section is highlighted. b. On that row, click Delete. The section is removed.
To change the standard statuses (columns) in your custom view,	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. On the lower right, click Options. The <i>Edit Custom View Options (Columns)</i> page opens. b. Select or clear the checkboxes for <i>Standard Statuses</i>. c. If appropriate, in the <i>Options</i> section, select or clear these checkboxes. d. Click Save.

3. If appropriate, select the **Make this custom view my default view** checkbox.

4. Click **Save**. Your customized view opens.
